

What's a 3D file?D?

A three-dimensional file of an object is a representation of it in 3 dimensions.

In the case of our taps or fittings, it can be viewed on a mobile device or computer to appreciate its details and look at it at 360 degrees.

The same file can be used to create 3D virtual environments called renders.

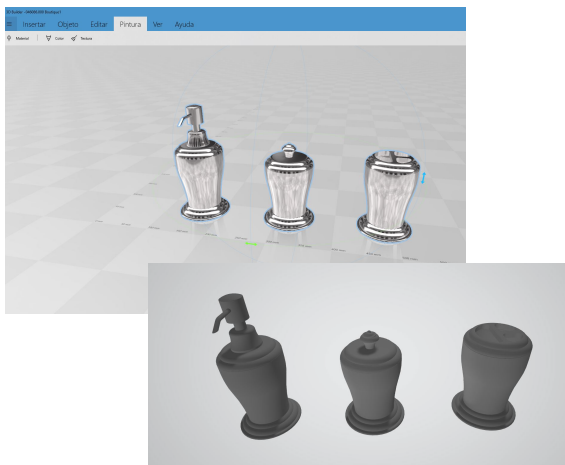
.DWG

It is an AUTOCAD file format for 2d and 3d projects.

It is compatible with all major 3d and rendering programs.

Mestre offers the 3D DWG version.

.3MF

It is another type of 3D file that, apart from the 3D object, also includes another file that **simulates the final finish of the object**. In our case, gold finish, chrome, etc.

This format **allows to visualize the object without the need of a specific program, simply with a standard computer viewer** can be opened and you can see the details of the object, and move it in space.
